

Ultimate Drill Book - Beam Application Privacy Policy

Introduction

Ultimate Drill Book ("**Company**" or "**We**") respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy. This policy describes:

- The types of information we may collect or that you may provide when you download, register with, access, or use the Beam application ("**Beam**").
- Our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

This policy applies only to information we collect in Beam, and in email, text, and other electronic communications sent through or in connection with Beam.

This policy DOES NOT apply to information that:

- We collect offline or on any other Company apps or websites, including websites you may access through Beam.

Our websites and apps may have their own privacy policies, which we encourage you to read before providing information on or through them.

Please read this policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, do not download, register with, or use Beam. By downloading, registering with, or using Beam, you agree to this privacy policy. This policy may change from time to time (see Changes to Our Privacy Policy). Your continued use of Beam after we revise this policy means you accept those changes, so please check the policy periodically for updates.

Children Under the Age of 13

Children under 13 using Beam are required to obtain parental consent before using Beam. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If we learn we have collected or received personal information from a child under 13 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information. Information We Collect and How We Collect It

We collect information from and about users of Beam:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us.
- Automatically when you use Beam.

Information You Provide to Us

When you download, register with, or use Beam, we may ask you provide information:

- By which you may be personally identified, such as name, postal address, email address, or telephone number ("**personal information**").

- Name and email address are the only required personal information for **student users** registering on Beam.

This information includes:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms in Beam. This includes information provided at the time of registering to use Beam and subscribing to our service. We may also ask you for information when you report a problem with Beam.
- Records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses and phone numbers) if you contact us.
- Details of transactions you carry out through Beam and of the fulfillment of your orders.

How We Use Your Information

We use information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including any personal information, to:

- Provide you with Beam and its contents, and any other information, products, or services that you request from us.
- Fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it.
- Give you notices about your account/subscription, including expiration and renewal notices.
- Carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, including for billing and collection.
- Notify you when Beam updates are available, and of changes to any products or services we offer or provide though it.

Disclosure of Your Information

We may disclose aggregated information about our users, and information that does not identify any individual without restriction.

In addition, we may disclose personal information that we collect or you provide:

- To our subsidiaries and affiliates.
- To contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our business and who are bound by contractual obligations to keep personal information confidential and use it only for the purposes for which we disclose it to them.
- To a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of Ultimate Drill Book's assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by Ultimate Drill Book about our Beam users is among the assets transferred.
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.
- With your consent.
- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.

- If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of Ultimate Drill Book, our customers, or others.

Accessing and Correcting Your Personal Information

You can review and change your personal information by logging into Beam and visiting your account profile page. If you want to delete your personal information, you may do so by deleting your user account in Beam.

Your State Privacy Rights

Data Security

The safety and security of your information also depends on you. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password for access to certain parts of Beam, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share your password with anyone.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet and mobile platforms is not completely secure. Although we do our best to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee the security of your personal information transmitted through Beam. Any transmission of personal information is at your own risk. We are not responsible for circumvention of any privacy settings or security measures we provide.

Changes to Our Privacy Policy

We may update our privacy policy from time to time. The date the privacy policy was last revised is identified at the top of the page. You are responsible for periodically visiting Beam and this privacy policy to check for any changes. In the event your home state updates its privacy laws after the date this privacy policy was last modified, such law will automatically be integrated into this policy.
